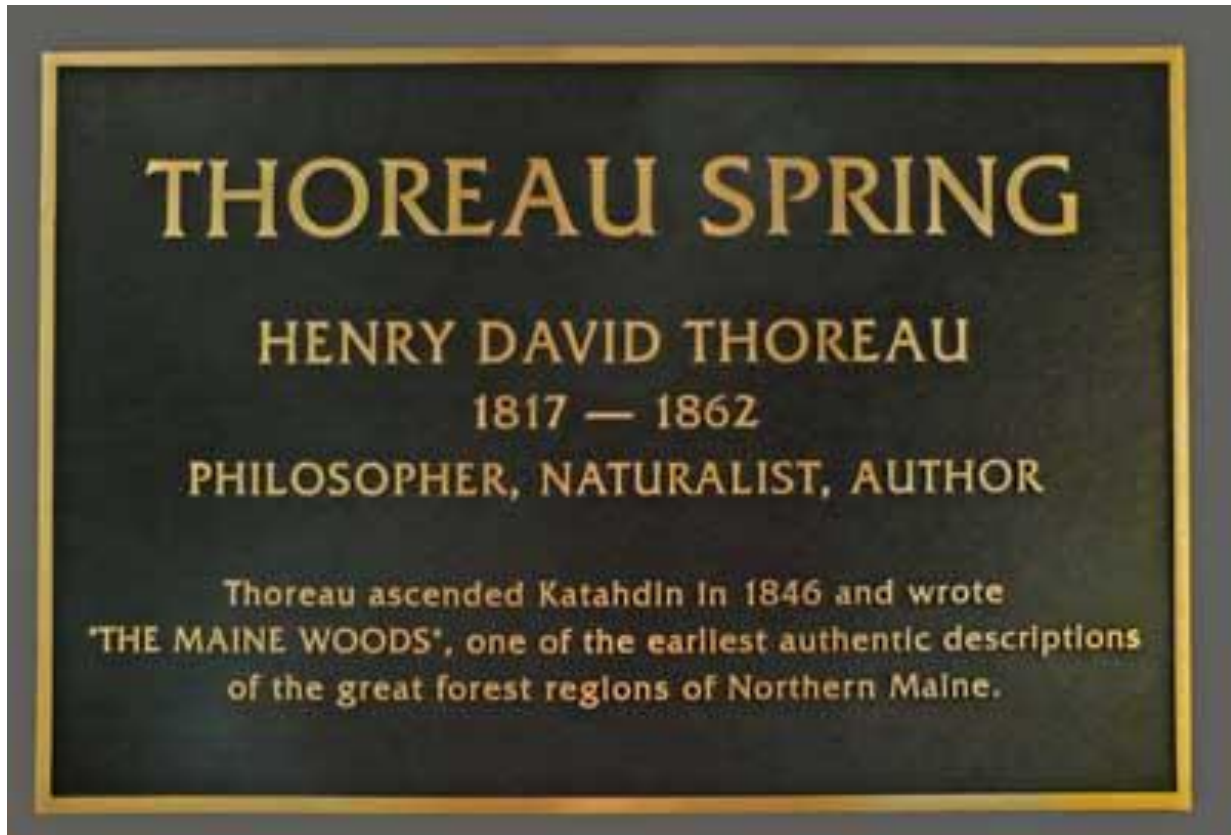
Below is the current monument:



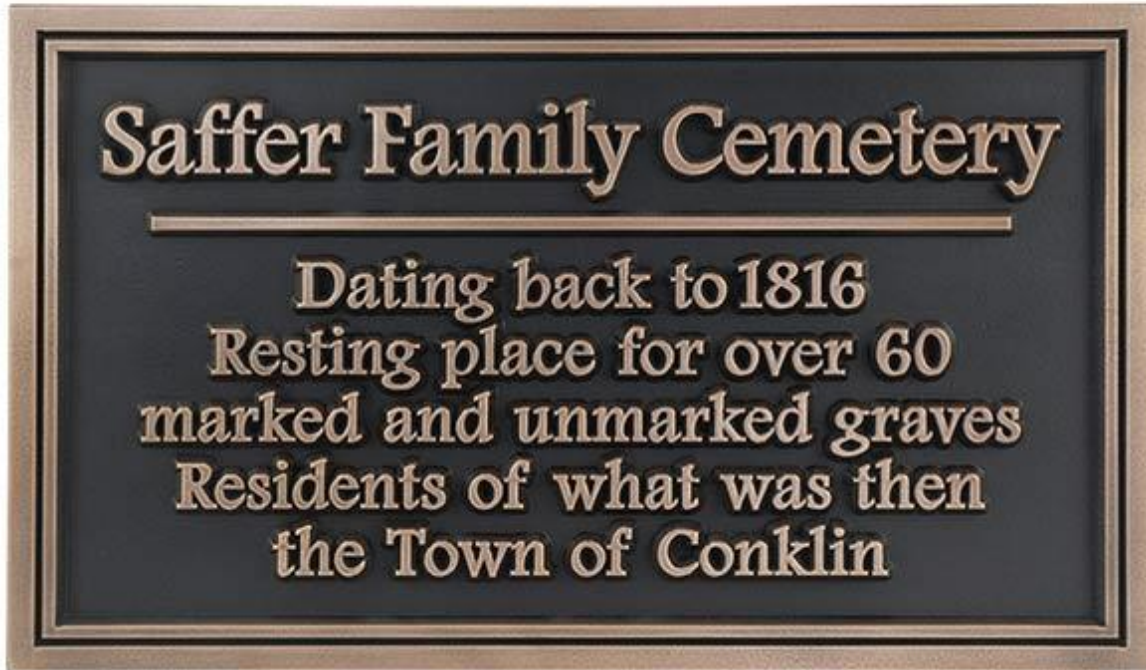
Please review the 3 samples provided and discuss as a Commission which plaque style best suits the purposes.
