## From the Mayor's Desk

November has come and we have enjoyed some great weather this fall. Leaves are changing and life is slowing down for most businesses (at least for a while). One new change that has occurred at Zion National Park is we now have a new superintendent, Jeff Bradybaugh. He comes to us from Bryce National Park but this isn't his first stint at Zion. Supt. Bradybaugh had an 8 year stay here previously as chief of resource management and research. He is excited to be back at Zion and we want to welcome him to our community. We will be holding a meet and greet reception for him at the CCC Thursday, November 13th from 5 until 7 PM. We invite everyone to come out and meet Supt. Bradybaugh that night.

The town has been busy with many things happening this summer. We just finished up with the music festival and have the Butch Cassidy 10K run on November 8th. While I was hoping to have great news that fiber optics is starting this month, we have to be patient as it is hitting a few snags. But it is still coming. The bus system from St. George to Zion is still progressing. UDOT is helping with a study that will be starting shortly. It seems we must always start with another study in government. We will be having a kickoff this month to start our streetlight project. This month also has the annual Lions' Club Turkey Shoot that is always fun. We cleaned out more of the water line inside the park and our newly installed manholes worked beautifully. There is still one more section that we need to do and that will happen this spring. We are continuing to work with the Paiute tribe on helping them establish a museum and cultural center that will work for both the town and the tribe. Progress has been made and a plan is in place.

These are just a few of the things that are going on in the town. For a small town of 550 people there sure are a lot of things going on.

We hope that as this holiday season arrives that you and your loved ones find peace and joy celebrating a wonderful year.

## Historical Walking Tours


3rd Tour: Springdale, Utah

The General Plan is the guiding document for future growth and development in the Town. The General Plan establishes a vision for the future character of the community. The Town Council and Planning Commission refer to the General Plan when making important decisions that impact the community. The General Plan is a very important tool used to help maintain the community character and feel.

The General Plan was last updated in 2010. The Planning Commission has begun the process of updating and revising the Plan. The Commission is using feedback received in two recent town-wide surveys and a public open house held earlier this year to help guide the revision process. However, additional input from residents, business owners, and visitors is vital to make sure the General Plan represents the collective vision of the community. The Commission will be discussing the General Plan update in their monthly work meetings, the first Tuesday of each month at 5:00pm. Please come and participate in the process.

## **Street Lighting Update**

The Town is preparing to replace the cobra-head style street lights on SR-9 with lights that are more energy efficient, less impacting on the night sky, and more in keeping with the architectural feel of the Town. The Town is making these changes to comply with the Outdoor Lighting Ordinance which requires all lights in the Town to be night sky friendly by 2016.

The Town has contracted with Forsgren and Associates Engineers to design the street light replacement project. Forsgren will work over the next few months to complete the project design. Meanwhile, the Town is exploring options to fund the project. The current schedule will have construction on the streetlight replacement project begin in early 2016, with the project complete by Easter weekend 2016.



All proceeds will go to benefit community projects, such as the Zion Canyon Veterans' Monument and reading glasses for local children
