## Police Corner

As many of you know, Chief Kurt Wright recently retired from the Springdale/Zion Canyon Police Department, and I have been appointed the new Chief of Police. I have also hired Trent Feltner to replace my position. Trent comes to us with almost 20 years of police experience, and will be huge asset to the community.



We have had several traffic accidents in the canyon lately. The most recent traffic accident was the head-on collision that happened on SR-9 at about mile marker 23. As the busy season in Springdale is in full swing, everyone should be mindful of others while driving. There is a lot of tourist vehicle traffic going up and down the canyon at all hours of the day. While some tourists are in a huge hurry to get to their destination, others are cruising at slower speeds and looking at the scenery.

We ask that business owners remind their employees to leave for work a little earlier than usual to give them time

to get to work safely. I would also remind residents to give themselves extra time to drive up and down the canyon. The Springdale/Zion Canyon Police have increased patrol on the entire length of the canyon road. We encourage people to call in and report aggressive driving and dangerous passing. It's always helpful to get a description of the suspect vehicle (make, model, color), direction of travel, and a license plate number if it is safe to do so. The police department will do everything they can to follow up with the driver, as we take these complaints seriously.

The goal of the police department is to ensure the safety of residents as well as those visiting the canyon. Please don't hesitate to call on an officer if you have questions or concerns. We are always here to help.

## Lighting Reviews Underway

The Town's outdoor lighting ordinance requires all outdoor light fixtures to comply with the standards in the ordinance by August 2016. To help property owners identify lighting that may need to be altered to comply with these standards the Town will be reviewing outdoor lighting on all properties throughout the Town.

Lighting reviewers will be visiting each property in Town to identify lights that do not comply with the ordinance. These reviews will occur in the late evening hours throughout the month of August. Property owners will be sent notice of any lights that do not meet the standards of the ordinance. These notices will be sent toward the end of September.

Lighting reviewers will investigate these concerns when they conduct their lighting reviews.
