The Springdale Zion Canyon Department of Public Safety would like to take the opportunity to wish you a very Happy Holiday Season and to ask your help in protecting yourself and your neighborhood by being aware of your surroundings. During the holidays, thieves take this opportunity to take advantage of others. Remember when out shopping to lock your homes and vehicles. Also keep valuables and items that you've purchased out-of-sight when left unattended in your locked vehicle. Keep your credit cards, pin numbers, and other information hidden so that it cannot be obtained and used by others fraudulently. We also want to ask that if you see any suspicious persons or activities that you call the police and report it.






