

Transit and Carpooling to Drive the Town to a Brighter Future

The Town's General Plan envisions a community where a variety of transportation choices are available. Rather than relying solely on private automobiles for transportation, the Town wants to encourage more use of walking, biking, transit and carpooling. Relying less on cars and more on other travel choices will reduce parking and traffic congestion, improve air quality, expand mobility for car-less populations, and promote a better village atmosphere.

The Town is particularly concerned about expanding transportation options for employees of Springdale businesses. Having employees who live out of town drive a private vehicle every day creates problems for both the employees and the Town. Employees incur extra travel costs that reduce their effective wages. The Town experiences more traffic and parking congestion from employee's vehicles.

To help provide more options for employees the Town is partnering with the Dixie Metropolitan Planning Organization and other communities along SR-9 to lay the groundwork for a public transportation route from St. George to Springdale. This route will provide an economical and reliable transportation option for employees who live in Hurricane, La Verkin, Virgin or other communities along the SR-9 corridor. It will also provide more transportation options for Springdale residents to travel to St. George or other areas of the county. Conducting more trips via transit will help reduce the negative impacts of traffic and parking congestion in Springdale.



The Town also encourages employees of Springdale businesses to carpool to work. Carpooling is an easy and convenient way for employees to save on transportation costs. The Town encourages employers to provide incentives to their employees who carpool. Employees who carpool benefit businesses by occupying fewer spaces in parking lots. Employees who carpool are also more likely to arrive to work on-time. Carpooling is a strategy that can be implemented immediately to reduce parking and traffic congestion. Please consider carpooling, or encouraging your employees to carpool.

The Town is continuing to address transportation issues like parking and traffic congestion through a variety of strategies, as outlined in the General Plan. There is no single answer to challenging transportation problems. But through a balanced and thoughtful approach the Town's transportation system can function effectively and efficiently.

SR-9 Reconstruction Project News



The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) continues to design the improvements to SR-9 from Rockville to Zion National Park. The project team anticipates construction will begin January 2017 for both the roadway resurfacing in Rockville and the resurfacing and shoulder widening from Rockville to Springdale. Roadway reconstruction through Springdale is currently scheduled to begin in late 2017.

COMMUNITY WORKING GROUP

The project team is currently evaluating improvements through Springdale, such as pedestrian facilities, and determining how traffic and access will be maintained during construction. A community working group is being formed to provide input and suggestions to the project team. UDOT would like to have various community interests represented in this working group, which will listen to ideas and review concepts regarding the project and provide valuable feedback that assists the project team in decision making. The group will meet for 90 minutes approximately every six weeks from October 2016 through Spring 2017 and during the Springdale construction that's scheduled to begin in late 2017. We're currently in need of additional group members, please contact us if you're interested in the project and willing to volunteer your time to assist the team. The group will contain no more than 15 members so we may not be able to accommodate everyone that responds.

Outdoor Lighting Ordinance Update

In August 2009 the Town adopted a comprehensive outdoor lighting ordinance. The ordinance regulates the design and placement of outdoor lights in order to protect the night sky, eliminate light trespass, and contribute to the Town's village atmosphere while also providing for safety and security. All new lighting installed after August 2009 needs to comply with the standards of the ordinance. Lighting that existed prior to August 2009 was granted a seven-year period to be brought into compliance. That period expired last month.

The Town has been working hard to bring lighting on public properties into compliance with the ordinance, including streetlights on SR-9. However, due to issues associated with the upcoming SR-9 reconstruction project beyond the Town's control, the streetlights have not yet been brought into compliance. The Town encourages all property owners to bring lights that existed prior to August 2009 into compliance with the outdoor lighting ordinance. However, the Town will delay active enforcement of the outdoor lighting standards on lights that existed prior to August 2009 until streetlights have been brought into compliance with the ordinance. The Town anticipates this to happen at the same time as the SR-9 road reconstruction—late 2017 / early 2018.
