Item C7: Relocation of Historic Structure from Harvest House to Town Park

The Harvest House Bed and Breakfast has a small historic structure in the back yard. Judging by the materials used and style of construction the structure dates to the early settlement of Springdale. However, the original use and location of the structure are unknown.

The Harvest House is planning a construction project which will require removal of the historic structure. The Harvest House owners have volunteered to donate the historic structure to the Town. The Historic Preservation Commission has looked at the structure and potential location on Town property where the structure could be relocated. The Commission recommends moving the structure to the area between the Community Center parking lot and the wash, just east of the Zion Canyon Medical Clinic. The structure could be used to showcase Springdale's early history.

The Commission has received a quote of \$300 to move the structure. Staff suggests the Professional and Technical Services account in the Community and Economic Development budget be used to cover the expense of moving the structure. Members of the Commission with construction expertise have volunteered their time and materials to assist in the relocation, including building a stone foundation for the structure to sit on.

Staff recommends the Council approve the use of the Town's property for the relocation of the structure.
