**Re:** **Blanket local consent requests for 2015**

---

**Overview**

The procedure to issue blanket local consent requests began in 2012. The blanket consent request provides a way for the Town Council to approve up to 12 single event permits per year, for an area business, all at once. This helps streamline the process for both Town staff and applicants. The blanket requests are compliant with DABC and Town policy.

Once the blanket consent is in place, the local venue fills out single event permit forms and pays the fee. The Town Clerk facilitates the Mayor's signature and submission of the forms to the DABC. Each individual permit request does not need to return to the Council for a vote. The Clerk is responsible for tracking issuance of the single event requests to insure they do not exceed 12 per blanket.

On the agenda are requests from three Springdale businesses for blanket local consent requests:

- Bit & Spur
- The Zion Canyon Brew Pub
- Wildcat Willies

**Staff recommendation:** Grant the local consent for up to 12 single event permits in 2015 for each of the businesses listed above.
