RESOLUTION NO. 2020-04

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SPRINGDALE IMPLEMENTING GOVERNOR HERBERT'S
EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-5 ALLOWING PUBLIC BODIES TO CONDUCT
PUBLIC MEETINGS ELECTRONICALLY**

Whereas, On March 6, 2020, Governor Gary R. Herbert issued Executive Order 2020-1 declaring a state of emergency in the state of Utah due to novel coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19); and

Whereas, On March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization characterized the COVID-19 outbreak as a pandemic; and

Whereas, On March 13, 2020, President Donald J. Trump declared a national state of emergency based on the continuing spread of COVID-19; and

Whereas, Federal, state, and local authorities have recommended that individuals limit public gatherings to ten or fewer to prevent and control the continuing spread of COVID-19; and

Whereas, On March 18, 2020 Governor Gary R. Herbert issued an Executive Order suspending the enforcement of provisions of Utah Code §§ 52-4-202 and 52-4-207, and related state agency orders, rules and regulations, due to infection disease COVID-19 novel coronavirus; and

Whereas, the Town of Springdale desires to continue to operate the municipality in an efficient and effective way while simultaneously protecting the health and safety of our residents and public officials;

Therefore, Town of Springdale public bodies shall be allowed to conduct public meetings and public hearings electronically with the following provisions:

1. provide a means by which interested persons and the public may remotely hear or observe by audio or video transmission the open portions of the meeting;
2. if comments from the public will be accepted during the electronic meeting, provide a means by which interested persons and the public participating remotely may ask questions and make comments by electronic means in the open portions of the meeting.
3. no quorum is required at the anchor location.
4. The public is not invited to the anchor location.

This Resolution shall remain in effect until the termination of the state of emergency declared in Executive Order 2020-1.
